## Message from the president



Dear colleagues,

First, thank you for your exceptional mobilization regarding the enrollment of new patients. Following discussions with the DTMF, we have received confirmation that many of you have stepped forward and that patients identified as “red” are currently in the process of being taken on in various clinics across Montreal. You should be proud of your efforts!

Furthermore, the adoption of Bill 19 on February 26 officially confirms the legislative changes and the end of the coercive provisions included in the previous law. This adoption allows to move forward with the implementation the 2023–2028 *Entente* concluded between the FMOQ and the government. In recent weeks, many of you have reached out to share your questions and concerns regarding the upcoming new remuneration model. Your questions and the issues raised are entirely legitimate. As we await more information from the FMOQ on the work underway, we remain available for you. We have relayed many of your questions and requests for *pratique particulière* (practices excluded from capitation) to the FMOQ for their review.

We remain attentive and fully committed and will share any new information with you as soon as we receive it. In the meantime, please continue to write to us - your questions and experiences directly inform and strengthen our advocacy work on your behalf.

Thank you for being there every day, providing care, covering call shifts, teaching the next generation, and contributing to research and innovation in our profession. Your dedication does not go unnoticed. Please remember to take breaks and take care of yourselves too.
